Local college access networks (LCANs) LCANs represent 82% of the state's population. These organizations are made up of community leaders who come together to create solutions and partnerships to support local talent development.




Statewide Initiatives FCAN coordinates 4 College Ready Florida initiatives that support students in continuing their education after high school.


Ensuring every Florida student graduates high school with a college or career plan, using the 4 E's:




** According to the Federal Reserve, in 2018, 69% of students took out student loans and graduated with the average debt of \$29,800.

HOW MANY JOBS DO YOU THINK YOU WILL HAVE AS AN ADULT?



HOW CONFIDENT DO YOU FEEL ABOUT ACHIEVING YOUR PLANS AFTER HIGH SCHOOL?












Poll: What do you think keeps students from filling out the FAFSA?



WHAT MIGHT KEEP YOU FROM FILLING OUT THE FAFSA APPLICATION?







WHO HAS HELPED YOU THE MOST WITH YOUR PLANS AFTER HIGH SCHOOL?




