WHAT WE DO


We are at the heart of a growing movement to realize Florida's untapped talent and potential. Our work demonstrates the tremendous possibilities that education can produce for all students.

FCAN's Impact... Going to College with Purpose

After Florentina Denis-McGary and her husband Marquis McGary, both 27, decided to enroll at Polk State College in 2017, the couple thought it might be a good idea to gamify the pursuit of their associate degrees. "Almost all our classes were together, so we made it a competition to see who could come out with the better grades," Florentina said. While Marquis may have edged Florentina out in terms of G.P.A., both spouses consider themselves huge winners after each earning associate degrees in health science from Polk State at the end of 2020.

I remember we were driving around one day, and I pointed to this really nice house and said, 'We're not going to be able to get a house like that with what we're doing right now," Marquis said. "We were both going to have to go back to school.

Florentina wants to become a physician's assistant — a licensed health care provider who requires more training than the more administrative-focused medical assistant — before working her way up to a position as a medical examiner.

She's also enjoying all the knowledge she has acquired along the way.

Ashley Rhodes-Courter, MSW, is the quintessential American success story. Born in 1985 to a single teen mother, by the age of 3 she was in Florida's foster care system where she spent almost ten years being shuttled between 14 homes—some quite abusive—before being adopted from a Children's Home at the age of twelve.

Despite her ordeal, she excelled in school because she believed that, "my education was the one thing nobody could take from me." Her efforts and academic achievements landed her Eckerd College's Trustee Scholarship where she graduated with honors and ahead of schedule earning a double major in Communications and Theater and a double minor in Political Science and Psychology. Ashley then went on to earn a Master's Degree in Social Work from the University of Southern California.

By the age of 22, Ashley had become a New York Times Bestselling Author. Her first book, "Three Little Words" is now an International Bestseller and has been published in at least 4 countries. Her second book, "Three More Words" debuted at #1 on Amazon Bestseller's List. Both books are used in classrooms across the country in various community and First Year Experience Collegiate programs. Ashley has received State, local, and National awards for her speaking, advocacy, and philanthropy. She has spoken on Capitol Hill and has been invited to the White House twice.

Enhancing students' access, success and the quality of their experiences are the most treasured values of Dr. Tonjua Williams, St. Petersburg College's seventh president. She has served SPC for 34 years, rising through the ranks in a variety of academic and administrative roles, including Senior Vice President for Student Services and Provost of the Tarpon Springs Campus.

Dr. Williams is nationally recognized as an expert in transforming departments and institutions through student development and strategic planning. She has received many awards and recognitions – most recently the National Institute for Staff and Organizational Development's John E. Roueche International Leadership Award, the Tampa Bay Business Journal's Businesswoman of the Year award, and as one of the top 25 women in higher education by Diverse Issues in Higher Education. Dr. Williams holds a Ph.D. from Barry University in Higher Education Administration with a specialization in Educational Leadership.

St. Petersburg College has flourished under her leadership, having just been named sixth best among public and private colleges in Florida according to U.S. News and World Report's 2020 study. That same report ranked SPC at number 17 among the top 84 public schools in the southern region, which is comprised of 12 states.

As SPC's president, Dr. Williams is creating a pathway for educators, businesses, government and community agencies to work closer together than ever before. As part of the Educational Ecosystem movement, alignment between schools is being strengthened, on and off ramps are being built for working adults to advance in their careers, and active partnerships with industry are being fortified with quality talent that improves the economic mobility of our residents and the growth of our region.
