- Currently our model is built with a 10-year plan of support





Defining Equity

Educational equity means that each child receives what they need to develop to their full academic and social potential. – National Equity Project

- Ensuring equally high outcomes for all participants in our educational system;
 removing the predictability of success or failures that current correlates with any social or cultural factor;
- Interrupting inequitable practices, examining biases, and creating inclusive multicultural school environments for adults and children; and
- Discovering and cultivating the unique gifts, talents and interests that every human possesses.



Defining Equity

To achieve equity in education

We must develop leaders who can...

Transform our institutions by eliminating inequitable practices and cultivate the unique gifts, talents, and interests of every child...

So that success and failure are no longer predictable by student identity - racial, cultural, economic, or any other social factor.



Equity with a College Counseling Lens


The pursuit of educational equity in college counseling can be simplified to:

- Pursuing equity in outcomes








