	Creat	e your FSA ID, the username and password that you will need to log into the Federal
	Stude	nt Aid website. Remember your password!
	0	You and your parent will each need to create your own FSA ID.
	0	Go to <u>studentaid.gov</u> to get started.
	Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).	
	0	Some aid is on a first-come, first-served basis. The earlier you complete the FAFSA, the
		more likely you are to receive some forms of financial aid.
	0	Go to <u>studentaid.gov</u> to get started.
	Comp	plete the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA).
	0	The FFAA opens October 1.
	0	It is necessary to complete this application to receive state-funded grants and
		scholarships, including Bright Futures.
	0	Complete the FFAA <u>here</u> .
	Apply	for grants and scholarships, which do not need to be paid back.
	0	Florida offers both need- and merit-based scholarships, including Bright Futures, First
		Generation Matching Grant, and Florida Student Assistance Grant.
	0	Some of these scholarships require that you complete the FFAA.
	0	Research local scholarships through your education foundation, community foundation
		or by speaking with your school counselor. Also, check out <u>FCAN's Scholarship</u>
		Resources page.
